

Workstations and Wi-Fi (EDUROAM) are available.

Borrowing

Academic staff can borrow up to 20 books for 60 days; Students can borrow up to 10 books for 30 days; External users can borrow up to 5 items for 30 days.

If you are a visitor (with no formal relationship with Padova University), you need a library card. You can buy it at the reception desk (cost: $1 \in$).

You can renew and reserve books online (http://catalogo.unipd.it:8991) or in person at the reception desk.

You can renew a book (5 times if you are a Student or Academic staff; twice if you are an external user), before the due date if not reserved by other users.

You can reserve only circulating books on loan.

You can borrow journals, encyclopaedias, and dictionaries overnight or for the weekend. You can borrow them from 5 pm to the next working day before 10 am (on friday from 12.30 am). Reservations and renewals in this case are not allowed.

Engineering libraries provide two copies of textbooks: the first one is non circulating, the second is available for a 15 days long loan.

There is a borrowing suspension as long as the overdue period (example: 5 days overdue = 5 days suspension).

Photocopying

There is a self-service multitasking photocopier in each library. You need to register an account on: http://unipd.albamyprint.it. Your account is linked to your University ID card.

Requesting articles and Interlibrary loans

Articles and books not available in Padova University Library System can be requested through document delivery (DD) and interlibrary loan (ILL) services: DD is generally free of charge, ILL is not for free. Please ask a librarian for more details.

If you have a University email account, you can contact us online: https://helpdesk.dei.unipd.it or you can come at the reception desk (Engineering Central Library: Tuesday and Wednesday from 10.00 to 12.00 am; Industrial Engineering Library: Monday and Wednesday from 2.00 to 4.00 pm; Information Engineering Library: Tuesday and Thursday from 2.00 to 4.00 p).
